The international Orchestral Academy of the Schleswig-Holstein Musik Festival has enjoyed a superb reputation worldwide since its founding in 1987 by Leonard Bernstein. Every year young musicians from all over the world are given the opportunity to study and perform great works with famous conductors. In addition, a team of principal players from top-rank orchestras and professors from European music academies leads chamber music and sectional rehearsals.

**Grant** After a successful audition, each musician will receive a grant to cover travel, bed and board and tuition expenses.

**Age limit** Musicians born after February 28, 1991

**Registration deadline** December 1, 2017 for auditions in Europe, USA, South America; November 17, 2017 for auditions in Asia

**Registration fee** 40 €; for auditions in South America 10 €

**Auditions** Amsterdam, Basel, Beijing, Berlin, Bloomington, Boston, Buenos Aires, Frankfurt, Hanover, Houston, Leipzig, London, Los Angeles, Madrid, Milan, Moskow, Munich, New York, Paris, Santiago de Chile, Sao Paulo, Seoul, Taipeh, Tel Aviv, Tokyo, Toronto, Wien, Zaragoza etc.
